Registration

Registration includes access to all sessions, the exhibition area, refreshments and lunch throughout the duration of the Study Day. All registered delegates will receive a copy of the Programme in their delegate packs which will be handed out at registration.

Delegate Badges

Cancellation and non-attendance

Please note that in the case of unforeseen circumstances requiring you to cancel your registration it will be possible to swap your registration with a colleague up until the day of the conference. If you cancel your registration less than 14 days in advance and you are unable to swap your registration with a colleague, we will do our utmost to find a replacement for you; if we are unable to do this, then a £50 cancellation fee will be due to cover the cost of catering. Any non-attendees on the day who have not provided a minimum 3 days' notice will be subject to a penalty fee of £150 as it is unlikely we will be able to replace your registration at this stage, leading to a less-than-full turnout on the day. This fee will also be used to recover costs.

Located at Hyde Park Corner and two minutes' walk from Marble Arch Underground Station.

Marble Arch Underground Station (Central Line) is 50 metres away. Take Exit 1 and on leaving the station turn right, walk past McDonald's restaurant on your right, and at the corner (adjacent to Sainsbury's) take the pedestrian crossing to the other side of Edgware Road. Having crossed the road turn right up the Edgware Road. Before reaching the bus stop and newsagent you will see Connaught Place on your left-hand side (approximately 10 metres from the pedestrian crossing) turn left into Connaught Place. **17 Connaught Place** is the first building on the right-hand side.

Marylebone Station, Euston Station and King's Cross St Pancras Station are all within 10 minutes' taxi ride, or alternatively, 15 minutes by tube. Paddington Station is 10 minutes' walk or 5 minutes by taxi.

The nearest NCP car parks are located on Connaught Street, or Park Lane. For a short stay, Connaught Place and the surrounding area have ample Pay & Display parking spaces.
