Registration

Cancellation and non-attendance

Please note that in the case of unforeseen circumstances requiring you to cancel your registration it will be possible to swap your registration with a colleague up until the day of the conference. No refunds will be made for cancellation of registration, but non-members will remain members of NHIVNA throughout 2011. If you cancel your registration less than 14 days in advance and you are unable to swap your registration with a colleague, we will do our utmost to find a replacement for you; if we are unable to do this, then a £50 cancellation fee will be due to cover the cost of catering. Any non-attendees on the day who have not provided a minimum 3 days' notice will be subject to a penalty fee of £150 as it is unlikely we will be able to replace your registration at this stage, leading to a less-than-full turnout on the day. This fee will also be used to recover costs.

The Manchester Conference Centre is located in the heart of Manchester city centre, just 300 metres from Manchester Piccadilly Station. The venue is in close proximity to Manchester Airport, the Greater Manchester metro link tram system, and central rail, bus and coach stations.

Manchester Conference Centre is within a three minute walk from Manchester Piccadilly Railway Station and Chorlton Street coach station.

By road: just off the A57M Mancunian Way at the A34 exit, with rapid links to the motorway network, including the M6, M56 and M1.

Manchester Oxford Road station, a convenient train station for delegates travelling from the North West, is just three minutes walk.

The venue is a five minutes tram journey from Manchester Victoria Railway Station.

The venue is adjacent to a 700 space multi-story car park which is on Charles Street.
