## **HIV Insight: History**

- Supported by a grant from Gilead Health Sciences Ltd
- Objective was to provide educational support for nurses that was directly linked to the NHIVNA competencies
- First modules released in 2009
- Now have 6 modules
  - 5 'basic'
  - 1 'advanced'



#### **Modules**

#### **Basic**

- 1. Understanding HIV
- 2. Caring for people with HIV
- 3. Anti-retroviral therapy
- 4. Health promotion
- 5. HIV testing

#### **Advanced**

1. Managing complexity in anti-retroviral therapy



# User Friendly HIV Insight Features

- Each module is composed of several short tutorials
- Users can complete tutorials and modules in short chunks of time & at their own pace
- Upon completion of a module, the user receives a certificate and a workbook



### **Key Topics**

- Full range of tutorials are accessed
- Most popular (by small margins) are: -
  - What is HIV?
  - HIV testing
  - Assessing health and well being
  - Opportunistic infections
  - ART




#### **Use of HIV Insight**


- Highly popular & highly accessed
- Total of 1,483 registered users (1,199 are 'active')
- In 2012: 880 completed tutorials
- In 2013 (so far): 692 completed tutorials



## HIV Insight is accessed from all over the world




#### Countries of Visitors Who Accessed /tutorials/tutorial.php






# Nurses appear to access HIV Insight throughout the day but mainly at lunchtime!
